The WOC will be looking for a volunteer to assist in the WOC Annual Audit.

Secretary:

As of March 2022, there are 601 WOC. 134 are West Sacramento residents representing (23%). There are 167 applicants on the Wait List 24 of these are West Sacramento residents.

As of March 2022, 265 members (44%) have met their WOC attendance/volunteer commitment.

Board Member Rick Tietz provided an overview of the March 26, 2022 Striper Derby. It was determined that Light 64 would be the outside boundary for fishing the Deep Water Channel for Derby purposes.

Port Captain Steve Johnson reports that the ramp repair project is projected to begin in May 2022. Final reviews and cost estimates are still needed to be obtained.
