License with West Sacramento. The City of West Sacramento has sent a longer-term license to the Commodore for signature. The Port Commission approved a license term of January 1, 2023 to March 31, 2027. Normally our licenses have been for 18 months at a time. The Port considered the percent of our members from West Sac (23%) in determining the license duration.

Shriners Hospital Toy Drive 2022. Sue and Rich Alcartado collected donations to purchase toys at the November and December Membership Meetings. Club members donated \$623.00 in cash, \$350.00 in checks and collected 43 toys. The toys and checks were delivered to the hospital December 17th, 2022. Thanks to Rich and Suzie as well as all members who made a donation.

Ramp. The ramp now extends to the end of our docks. The "usable" ramp is 2 feet from the dock end. A trailer "wheel drop" section extends 2 feet beyond that but is not intended for use, it is a safety feature to prevent you driving your trailer off the end of the ramp.

Some members with low-profile trailers will have to continue avoiding launching or retrieving at 2.0-foot or lower tides. All members should ensure their motors are in the full-up position for launching and retrieving their boat (after motoring or retrieving their boats and prior to leaving the ramp). The majority of our boats should now be able to launch and retrieve their boats at all but the 2.0 foot and lower tides.

Note: One of the upper grates has come loose and cannot be reattached until we have lower tides. The ramp is safe to use if you stay near the middle of the ramp. You may feel more of a "bump" launching and retrieving your boat but, other than that, you will be OK.

WOC Fishing Equipment Donation/Auction Fundraiser. The auction of WOC members' donated fishing gear netted \$641.36 (the WOC receives 90%, \$577.22). We are considering this for an annual event, October & November Membership meetings collections. Thanks to member Kevin Geckeler for heading up this effort and to all members who donated equipment.
