Port Captain – Paul Yu-Yang – Ramp, docks, gangway, parking lots, lighting, roads, shed.

Ramp. The ramp now extends to the end of our docks. The "usable" ramp is 2 feet from the dock end. A trailer "wheel drop" section extends 2 feet beyond that but is not intended for use, it is a safety feature to prevent you driving your trailer off the end of the ramp.

Some members with low-profile trailers (less than 9 ½ inches trailer cross-support beam to the ground) will have to continue avoiding launching or retrieving at 2.0-foot or lower tides. All members should ensure their motors are in the full-up position for launching and retrieving their boat (after motoring or retrieving their boats and prior to leaving the ramp). The majority of our boats should now be able to launch and retrieve their boats at all but the 2.0 foot and lower tides.

Note: One of the upper grates has come loose and cannot be reattached until we have lower tides. This should be fixed by the time of the March 18th Derby. The ramp is safe to use if you stay near the middle of the ramp. You may feel more of a "bump" launching and retrieving your boat but, other than that, you will be OK.

Tide Tables. The 2023 tide tables are on our web site <u>Tide Tables</u> (<u>washingtonoutboardclub.org</u>). Remember to add one hour during daylight savings time (starts March 12th).
