The meeting was called to order by Commodore Thurman Watson at 7:00 p.m.

Secretary Tom Lee read the August 11, 2022 minutes and they were approved as read.

Purser Report:

The report was approved as read.

Vice Commodore Mike Zimmerman gave an overview of our efforts for new member orientation and sign-ups. Mike introduced the new members in attendance and the membership at large voted them in.

Secretary Lee reported as of September 1, 2022, there are 569 WOC members. 143 are West Sacramento residents representing (25%). 55 members have completed their annual activity requirement.

Board Member Rick Tietz explained the timeframes and logistics for the October 22, 2022 Striper Derby. There will be a 5:00 a.m. launch time and 2:00 p.m. lines out. Lunch will be served and trophies will be given out to the First, Second, and Third Place winners.
