## Hazards on Ramp !

**No** ramp use by Big Inboards or large Outboards on low tides ! ( Over 16ft. )

Our Ramp is being damaged by large heavy boats during low tides. The 21ft and 3500lb limits were meant for normal tides not at the bottom of the tide. With a 2.8 or less tide there isn't enough water on the ramp to float the larger boats. There is now some actual damage to the metal structure that is supporting the lower part of the ramp.

We are working on doing some repairs soon, hopefully before any more damage occurs to our ramp. They must be done or we will have to close the Ramp period ! Please pass this info on to others !!!

Check the Website frequently for repair dates and times when we will close the ramp to all traffic !

Temporary end of Ramp Sign. The damaged section is just passed the pole. Going past the pole with your boat trailer on a low tide can cause more damage to the metal extension of the Ramp.

Tandem axle trailers can get stuck going past the sign on a low tide !



The Low Tide RED LINE indicator is at a 2.8 ft. Tide.

Use of the ramp at any water level below this line is restricted to vessels 16ft. or less.
